FEES COVER - Trail ride x 4 days, all evening events, and morning & evening meals (Our catered meals will begin Monday evening, and the last will be Friday noon). Meals will be served at Horseman's Hideaway stage area.

BRIDLE TAGS are separate & should be purchased at the State Office, or gate if you do not already have them.

STATE REQUIREMENTS: Out of state riders need to have a current coggins and health certificate on each horse. Horses will be checked this year.

Rules

- 1 We reserve the right to reject any reservation.
- 2 Any breed of horse or pony acceptable. Neither stallions nor mares with foals are allowed.
- 3 We discourage bringing dogs, but if you must, they **must** be on a leash at all times. No dogs on the trail.
- 4 No firearms allowed.
- 5 No littering or cowboying.
- 6 You will be expelled from our ride and the park if there is any obnoxious behavior.
- 7 Trail courtesies at all times.
- 8 Trail bosses have absolute authority.
- 9 An adult must accompany all minors (<18).
- 10 The Emerald Ash Bore has become a big problem. To prevent this from getting worse **DO NOT** bring your own firewood into the forestry.

ATTENTION READ CAREFULLY!

1. Camping reservations must be made through the state park system, with O'Bannon Woods State Park; formally Harrison-Crawford State Forest

2. Ride reservations must be made with Old Capitol Saddle Club. See attached reservation form.

O'Bannon Woods State Park; formally Harrison-Crawford State Forest

The forest has 25,000 acres with some of the most beautiful horse trails in Indiana. It has two major rivers, the Ohio River & Blue River. You can ride and enjoy tubing on the Blue River. There is also Indian Creek. The trails are very scenic, rating from moderate to rugged terrain.

The campground has wooded, shaded campsites with water nearby, horse wash stations and horse tie racks. There is primitive camping with showers, & full electric camping. Generators are allowed, check rules for your campsite. The park offers a pool with water slides.
